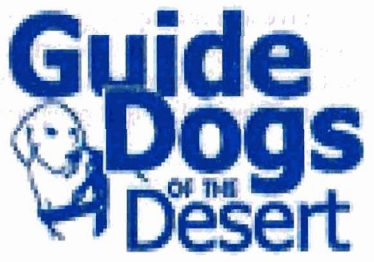

Guide Dogs of the Desert (GDD)

Guide Dogs of the Desert (GDD) was founded in 1972 by Lion Bud Maynard. This facility is located in North Palm Springs, California. GDD provides for safe mobility, loving companionship and the "miracle of independence" to the blind through the use of a guide dog. The Mission of GDD is to improve the lives of the blind by creating opportunities for life-changing independence, and by conducting community outreach and education programs. Since their inception, the GDD has graduated more than 1,000 student/dog teams at no cost to the recipient.

Loma Linda Lions Eye Foundation (LLLEF)

The primary purpose of the LLLEF is to guarantee to all members of the community availability of eye services and treatment. Needed eye treatment for both paying and indigent patients is provided through the Loma Linda University Eye Medical Group by a Lions Club referral process. The LLLEF specific objectives are the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment and care of eye diseases. LLLEF is managed by a Board of Trustees consisting solely of Lions Club members who serve without compensation.

California Lions Friends-In-Sight (FIS)

FIS provides free vision screening and distributes free recycled glasses to those who cannot afford eye care. This organization conducts monthly and semi-annual clinics in various locations in Southern California and northern Baja California, Mexico. Last year alone, over 11,000 people were served under this program. This program consists solely of dedicated volunteers and doctors who serve without compensation.
